

Directions to Kenneth Copeland Ministries Europe Office, Bath

85-87 Locksbrook Road, Lower Weston, Bath, BA1 3EN. Tel. 01225 787310

NB If you use a SatNav, once nearly at your destination, do not turn off Locksbrook Road into Kaynton Mead! Our building is on Locksbrook Road.

From the M4

Exit at Junction 18 and take A46 to Bath.

After passing the entrance to Dyrham Park on your right (¾-1 mile), travel for another ½ mile, and when the road rises slightly, take the right turn using the marked filter lane (tea/coffee house on right at this point).

At the next junction (approx. 1 mile), turn right and **immediately left** (it's not quite a crossroads): signposted to Hamswell and Park & Ride.

After 1½ - 2 miles, as you are going up quite a steep hill, you meet another road coming from the right (**not your right of way**); join this road and continue up the hill (virtually straight on).

After a long straight stretch, past Bath Racecourse and Golf Club on your right, the road bends slightly left by the Blathwayt Country Pub.

Take the next right turn (filter lane), signposted Weston. Follow this road all the way down, forking left at the roundabout at the end of the decline, and on past Weston village. Continue past the Royal United Hospital (on your right).

About ¼ mile past the hospital, go straight across at the mini-roundabout (it is actually left at the roundabout, followed by an immediate right turn) into Chelsea Road – narrow road with shops both sides.

At the crossroads ('Stop' sign), go straight across, and down to another cross-roads/mini-roundabout. Locksbrook Road is both left and right. Turn **right** – road is narrow with houses on both sides. KCM is on the left after about ¼ mile.

From A36 from Warminster and the South-East

Take the inner ring road, signposted A36 Bristol. Go straight across at Bathwick roundabout (St Mary's Church on left), and straight on at traffic lights ¼ mile further on, under railway bridge. Follow the main road as it bears right in Widcombe, past Widcombe Baptist Church on right. At the end of a short stretch of dual carriageway, you come to a large roundabout, with the railway running parallel to you on a viaduct up to your right. Take the second exit, signposted A36 Bristol. This is immediately after you have passed under the railway viaduct.

After the first light-controlled road junction (approx ½ mile), take the middle lane, direction Bristol, through light-controlled pedestrian crossing, and go straight across at next light-controlled junction. (Sainsbury's petrol station is on your right.)

Approaching the next light-controlled junction (600 yards), take the right lane (Wellsway Motors on right). Turn right at the lights, across Windsor Bridge, and turn left at lights at the end of the bridge. As the main road bends right and rises slightly, fork left into Locksbrook Road (newsagent on left corner). Pass through the small trading estate, straight across the next junction (small mini-roundabout). KCM is on the left after about ¼-mile.

over....

From the South, via A367

Follow the A367 into the city until you come down a hill to a large roundabout, with the railway viaduct in front of you. Keep to the left lane and take the first exit from the roundabout, signposted A36 Bristol. From there follow the instructions given in the route from Warminster and the South-East, starting with the second paragraph.

From Chippenham and the East, along the A4

As you drive into Bath along the London Road take the outside lane, as the inside one is a bus lane. Pass Morrisons supermarket entrance on left and Walcot petrol station on right. Keep in the outside lane, and go straight on at the traffic light-controlled junction, **not left** along inner ring road to Bristol, Warminster, etc

At mini-roundabout (200 yards), go straight on, not the left fork. Keep St Swithun's Church on your left. At the next traffic lights (¼ mile), keep in the left lane, following the main road as it bears right (left turn is prohibited).

After 300 yards, follow the main road as it turns 90 degrees left, down the hill into Queen's Square. Go round three sides of the square, and take the second exit (Charlotte Street), signposted A4 Bristol.

Almost immediately, pass the main entrance to Charlotte Street car park on the right. After about ½ mile, pass the Argos store on the left and Royal Victoria Park on the right with its unmistakable children's playground. As you approach the next traffic lights, keep in the right-hand lane and go straight on. As the main road bends right and rises slightly, fork left into Locksbrook Road (newsagent on left corner). Pass through the small trading estate, straight across the next junction (small mini-roundabout). KCM is on the left after about ¼-mile.

From Bristol

Take the A4 towards Bath. After the large roundabout by the Globe public house near Newton St Loe, there is a half-mile stretch of dual carriageway. At the end of this, take the left fork marked A4 City Centre, taking you across a bridge and then past the park-and-ride on your left.

(N.B. Do not be tempted to turn right into Brassmill Lane at the next crossroads, as you will come to the wrong end of a one way street before reaching the office.)

After about ½ mile, pass Hartwells Garage on the right, and after a further ¼ mile there is a light-controlled pedestrian crossing, with Lower Weston Post Office on your right. Turn right into Station Road at the crossroads immediately past the crossing. Go down to the crossroads/mini-roundabout. Locksbrook Road is both left and right. Turn **right** – road is narrow with houses on both sides. KCM is on the left after about ¼-mile.

From the South-West (A39)

Stay on the A39 until you reach the roundabout junction with the A4 at the Globe public house near Newton St Loe. Take the A4 towards Bath, and follow the directions as 'from Bristol' above.

Parking

Be careful as you turn left immediately after our building which is clearly marked 'Kenneth Copeland Ministries' and left again into our fenced off parking area.. There can be large lorries or other vehicles coming out of this turning.

Leave your vehicle and come back to the front of the building to access our offices through the front door on Locksbrook Road. Please ring the bell to the left of the door and someone will let you in.
